2025 Post-School Destinations

Queensland Pathways State College

This is a summary of the post-school destinations of students from Queensland Pathways State College who completed Year 12 and gained a Senior Statement in 2024. The results are from the *Year 12 Completers Survey*, which is conducted approximately six months after students completed Year 12.

77.7% response rate

108 out of 139 Year 12 completers from this school responded to the 2025 survey.
Results may not be representative of all Year 12 completers at this school.

Post-school destinations



In 2025, 64.8% of Year 12 completers from Queensland Pathways State College were engaged in education, training or employment in the year after they completed school.




Of the 108 respondents, 29.6% continued in education and training. The most common study destination was VET certificate.



A further 35.2% transitioned directly into paid employment only.

All Year 12 completers were assigned to a *main destination*. Respondents who were both studying and working are reported as being in education or training, including apprentices and trainees.
